CLUB TIMELINE SYNOPSIS

From: SHGSPC Board

To: ALL SHGSPC Members

As our club evolves, the following timeline/club required criteria synopsis is shared for all to keep in mind as we proceed in a new year:

- SHGSP Club is mandated by AKC and our Bylaws to hold a minimum of SIX (6) Meetings during the fiscal year (January – December). Meeting Announcement Notices are sent out to the membership electronically and/or by US Mail (Member's Choice). Plan to attend ALL members welcome and encouraged to attend!
- There are 4 – Working - Board & General Meetings held at the Galleria Mall in Middletown, NY (Feb, April, June (Annual Meeting and Elections) & October.
- There are 2 – Event - Board & General Meetings - August Pot Luck/Educational Event & November Awards Dinner.
- A quorum of 20% of ACTIVE Membership is required at ALL General Meetings to vote on and move “business” forward.
- ACTIVE Members are those who are willing and able to attend meetings, work on committees and at events... and are entitled to vote.
- Updated Membership Lists are forwarded to ALL members during the year, when you receive a new Membership List...kindly review your information and report any errors and/or corrections a.s.a.p. to: Detta@optonline.net. The club is required to submit membership information to the AKC annually, therefore it is most important to keep this updated.
- The first Specialty Show of the year is held in February with the Winter Garden Specialties in Rye, NY, the weekend before Westminster.
- Nominations from the Nominating Committee and the floor are accepted at the April Meeting.
- The second Specialty Show is held in June with the Shawangunk Mountain Cluster in New Paltz, NY.
- The annual Hunt Tests are held in September at East Mountain Preserve in Dover Plains, NY.
- Our Annual Awards Dinner Meeting is held the first Saturday in November. We gather in a private room at Delancy's Restaurant Goshen, NY. There is a minimum head count to rent this room. Please respond when requested...and advise if you will or will not - be able to attend.

- The member portion of the Awards Dinner payment is due on or before October 20th. All checks received will be deposited after the dinner. We have been forced to require this in order to be certain of head count for restaurant.
- Members who have attained AKC titles with their German Shorthaired Pointers during October 1, 2018 – September 30, 2019 are eligible for SHGSPC Certificates of Achievement. A copy or texted/emailed picture of the title certificate needs to be sent to Sandy Clark by October 25, 2019. IT IS MOST HELPFUL IF YOU SEND THIS AS SOON AS YOU RECEIVE YOUR CERTIFICATE AT ANY POINT DURING THE YEAR.
- Individual Member to Member sponsored awards, SHGSP Club Sponsored Awards, Requirements for SHGSPC AKC Certificate of Achievement details will be publicized.
- The Awards Committee is working on further acknowledgement of active members, please be sure to sign in when WORKING at future events with the event chairperson.
- Upcoming Club Annual Dues – Invoice with return envelope are distributed in November per Club Bylaws. Dues are due for the upcoming year on or before January 1, 2020.
- Membership is terminated if dues are not paid within 60 days of January 1st.
- The club is also mandated by the IRS, therefore the following must be requested in the future for proper accounting purposes:
 - All checks issued to SHGSPC must be for a singular purpose (ie dues in one check, trophy donations must be in a separate check, they cannot be combined in one.)
 - For all events where funds are collected, the event chairperson must complete a Profit/Loss Statement to close out the event.

Sandy reported that the club must keep in mind that since it is a functioning AKC Sanctioned Club and also a NYS Corporation, it is structured and mandated by IRS, NYS, AKC and the GSPCA to:

- Follow rules and regulations
- Be pro-active in numerous compliance protocols
- Be timely in meeting all necessary deadlines.

In addition to our operational mandated obligations, our club puts on numerous AKC Events throughout each calendar year (i.e. Shows/ Hunt Tests/ Education Programs/ AKC Awards Dinner Presentation).

All of this would not be possible without a strong core of dedicated diligent volunteer members.

Denise went on to explain that the idea and driving force for the concept of the Awards Dinner is to acknowledge the members who work so hard conducting club business, and give so much of themselves to organize and hold club functions, as well as to celebrate the accomplishments of members who are active and achieving honors with their GSPs. The thought behind the club paying for “active” members’ dinners is a “give back” for their efforts in keeping this club so successful. In previous years during our Annual Awards Event... we acknowledge and pay tribute to the GSP’s and handlers that have attain their AKC Titles.
