# Overnight & Reserved Day Parking

Self-contained RVs and trailers will be allowed to setup overnight on the show site in designated areas starting at 3:00 P.M. on Wednesday. All parking will be on a first come, first served basis (see pre-registration form in this premium list) and there will be NO saving of spaces the day of the show. All parking will be under the direction of the overnight parking attendant and the event committee. There are no special accommodations for handicap RV parking. Generators must be turned off between the hours of 11:00 P.M. and 6:00 A.M. Overnight security will be on duty. Most spaces are approximately 30' wide x 40' deep and you must fit in the space you are assigned. This includes slides, ex-pens, tow vehicles and additional vehicles. If you use chips or paper in your ex-pens, please clean up the area prior to leaving the show.

**ELECTRIC AND WATER HOOKUPS:** Those requesting electric will be assigned in order of receipt of pre-registration, with preferences given to those staying all five days. ... at a Specialty the dog designated Reserve Winners Dog and the bitch designated Reserve Winners Bitch will be awarded a three-point major, provided that the number of dogs competing in the regular classes of the Reserve Winners' sex totals at least <a href="Mulecting IVICE">TWICE</a> the number required for a five point major, in the region in which the event is held. No major for Reserve Winners shall be given based upon an award of Best of Winners.

#### ATTENTION OWNERS/EXHIBITORS OF FOREIGN REGISTERED DOGS

If you are the owner/exhibitor of a dog registered with a foreign registry (not yet dual registered with AKC) please review the eligibility requirements in The Rules Applying to Dog Shows, chapter 11 section 1.

- Dogs must be individually registered with the American Kennel Club by the day of the event to be eligible for exhibit in the Bred by Exhibitor class.
- 2. Dogs are eligible to compete in AKC events using the foreign registration for a period of 30 days. That 30-day period begins with the date of first exhibit, regardless of whether the dog earned any points or awards. To continue to compete in AKC events beyond the initial 30-day period the dog must be either individually AKC registered or by the date of the event have been granted an extension to exhibit using the foreign registration. The owner or agent can request an extension using the form found on the AKC Web site at: http://images.akc.org/pdf/extenap.pdf

If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- 4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed.
